MSMPA January 10th, 2024, Secretary Minutes-

On January 10th, the meeting was called to order by President Tony Schwering at 7:00 pm, at the Waseca County East Annex, in Waseca, MN as well as via Google Meets online. The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance. We had 17 members in attendance, representing Waseca, Steele, Nicollet, LeSueur, and Hennepin Counties.

The **Treasurer's report** was read by ShaLee, with a Checking account balance of \$6,142.17,

The **Savings Account** has a current balance of \$1359.08. The **Disaster Fund** has \$310.00. The Disaster Fund is supplied by \$20 of each County's annual membership dues and is used to provide a donation or gift to a Member of a MSMPA Membership County, who may be in a special time of need. The Disaster Fund is in the Savings Account, to keep this separate from the Checking Account.

ShaLee W has submitted Form 1023 to the IRS to have the 501(c)(3) Reinstated. 4-24-2023. Per the IRS website Could take up to 180 days to get an updated status. ShaLee received a letter in the mail the first week of January, explaining they needed more information by December 12, 2023. ShaLee did fax back the additional information on 01/09/2024. Status: Still Pending

MSMPA Scholarship: Marty M. is the Chairman of this Scholarship Fund. The account is held at the MidCountry Bank.

Current Balance: \$9,128.97.

2024 Scholarship applications are due by February 1st, 2024.

Don Eustice Scholarship: Becky S gave the updated Current balance of the Don Eustice Scholarship Fund, held at the United Prairie Bank: \$29,266.10, with an interest rate of .03%

Becky is going to check around with other banks to see if she can get a better rate than .003% interest on this savings account with United Prairie. Bob Kahlow mentioned moving \$20,000 to a CD account, to earn more money for the account.
